Facility:

Cape Central Pool is 25 yards by 50 meters. It is equipped with a Colorado fully-automatic timing system with a horn start. Continuous warm-up/warm-down space is provided during the competition. Ten lanes (SCY) will be used for competition.

Directions:

From I-55/Exit 96/Route K: Head east off the exit (also known as William Street). After approximately 1.5 miles, turn left at Kingshighway and go north. Turn right at the next stoplight (Independence). Go approximately two blocks and turn left on Clark Street. After turning on Clark Street, the pool is off to the right. Eligibility:

Open to all AAU-registered swimmers of the SMSC Conference who have met the following requirements:

- and**
1. Swam in at least 3 SMSC meets during the 2015 summer schedule
 2. Swam in at least 9 events (individual or relay) during the 2015 summer schedule

Rules:

Current SMSC Swimming rules shall govern the meet. All swimmers who are not accompanied by an SMSC registered coach should report to the meet referee or meet director for warm-up instructions prior to the warm-up session. The swimmer will then be assigned to a coach on deck.

No cell phones or video cameras are allowed in locker rooms.

The areas on the pool deck behind the starting blocks are restricted for use by the athletes, coaches, officials, timers and other meet officials. Also, the area reserved for coaches is restricted for use by the athletes, coaches, officials, and other meet officials.

Age groups are as follows (girls and boys): 8 & Under; 9-10; 11-12; 13-14; 15-18.
The swimmer's age on June 1, 2015 determines the age group for the swimmer.

Timing:

Stopwatches and touch pads will be used. Participating teams will be responsible for providing a number of timers proportional to the number of swimmers each team enters.

- We will have hybrid timer groups. The lanes assigned to each team will be chosen by random drawing.
- Because touch pads are being used, only two timers per lane are required (one timer will need to push the plunger button and stop his/her watch at the end of each race).

Events:

All events will be timed finals. Standard SMSC events will be offered, **with the exception of 6 & Under events**. The *Hy-Tek Team Manager* event file is available on the SMSC website.

Entry Fees/Info:

\$2.00 per individual event and \$4.00 per relay team.

Entry fees should be delivered directly to the SMSC Treasurer Julie King or SMSC Secretary Jason Cravens at the meet.

Entry Process:

The SMSC will only accept entries via e-mail in *Team Manager* entry file or Team Unify file compatible with the Hytek Meet Manager software used to run the meet database.

1. Download the TM/MM event file available at www.smscswim.com on the meet schedule page.
2. Import this into *Team Manager*, and complete your team's entries.
3. Export an entry file and e-mail this file as an attachment to Jason Cravens at jcravens@rivercityaquatics.org.

All teams entering the meet are responsible for sending an entry file that is compatible with *Meet Manager*.

Parents should make any entry request, or change request via their team's coach and/or team's entry secretary.

Entry Times:

Coaches should enter swimmers' times in short course yards format only. (If you have times in TM it will take care of this---if you make up a seed time make it a Y time)

- All entries must be accompanied by a seed time (which can be made up if absolutely necessary). Entries with a seed time of "NT" will not be accepted.

Entry Limit:

Swimmers are limited to 3 individual events and 2 relay events.

- Coaches may enter as many relay teams as they wish; but may designate only two relays per event as a "scoring relay." All other relays must be entered as exhibition (check the "EX" box on *Team Manager*).
- Relays may include no more than 2 "aged-up" swimmers, and no swimmer may be "aged-up" more than one age group.

Entry Deadline:

All entries must be received by **Sunday, July 12, 2015 @ 9:00pm**. It is very important to meet this deadline so that the meet can be pre-seeded and meet programs/heat sheets can be printed. Please include a series of phone numbers of persons who may be contacted in order to resolve any entries problems that may arise.

Awards & Scoring:

Individual Events: 1st – 10th medals, 11th – 20th ribbons

High Point: Trophies for each age group of boys and girls

Relays: 1st – 5th medals, 6th – 10th ribbons

Team: Plaques for Large and Small Divisions

Individual Events: 24-21-20-19-18-17-16-15-14-13-11-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay Events: 48-42-40-38-36-34-32-30-28-26-22-18-16-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Important Reminders:

- **The Bullpen will only be used for individual events.** Relays must report to the block and should be organized by team coaches or parent volunteers.
- Large teams should provide a volunteer(s) to assist the bullpen workers in organizing swimmers, especially with the session 1 kids (8&under, 9-10 age groups)
- Concessions, heat sheets and consignments will be sold at the meet by River City Aquatics
