2016 will determine the age for the meet (the first day of  
competition at the Junior Olympics)

**Swimmers who have qualified at other meets will swim  
exhibition only. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals will be awarded to  
exhibition swimmers. Please be sure to mark exhibition when  
appropriate.**

**\*\*\*Awards must be picked up by the coach or team representative. Due to the expense of the medals, MEDALS WILL BE ORDERED AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE MEET. They will be handed to the Teams' coaches at a later date**

Swimmers must check in with the clerk 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to report promptly to the bullpen when their event is called.

Please allow 10 days for membership to be processed.
