Time & Place: Friday, June 23, 8:00 a.m. Sheryl Crow Aquatic Center, 211 First St., Kennett, MO

Pool Course: 25-meter short course, 8 lanes

Timing: Each team will be responsible for timers throughout the meet. Lane assignments will be made based on number of swimmers entered in the meet for each team.

Eligibility: Open to all AAU-registered swimmers of the SMSC Conference

Age Groups: 6 & Under, 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18. Age on June 1, 2017 will determine age group.

Events: All individual events, no relays. Swimmers may compete in 4 events. Team manager event file available on the SMSC website. If any swimmer is in a bind regarding events, we will allow 5 events for a swimmer. Please only enter a swimmer in 5 events if he/she needs the 5th event in order to qualify for finals. 13-18 year old swimmers will be swimming 50 meter events (Free, Back, Breast, and Fly) and 100 meter IM; therefore no Champ Free event for these age groups.

We did this to speed up the meet and to make it more fun for our older swimmers.

The event numbers were left the same as a regular SMSC Meet to avoid confusion with the swimmers remembering their regular event numbers. For example, we will start the meet with event #11A Girls 6 and under Freestyle.
